Where xxx represents the drive type (520 or 910 etc)

Where y represents the number of drives installed.

Accessories and upgrades are also End of Life effective 1<sup>st</sup> November 2004 and End of Supply effective 31<sup>st</sup> December 2004.

The M500 product has been End of Life since 1<sup>st</sup> April 2003.
